

My Garlic Growing Checklist

OCTOBER

- Plant garlic cloves before ground freezes
- Choose sunny spot
- Cover with 2 inches of soil

NOVEMBER

- Add mulch (straw or leaves)
- Protect cloves for winter
- Wait for spring!

APRIL

- Remove extra mulch
- Watch green shoots grow
- Water if soil is dry

MAY

- Water weekly
- Pull small weeds
- Watch for scapes (hardneck types)

JUNE

- Cut scapes to help bulbs grow
- Stop watering when leaves yellow
- Check plant health

JULY

- Harvest when lower leaves brown
- Loosen soil carefully
- Cure bulbs in dry shady place

AUGUST

- Trim roots and tops after curing
- Store in cool dry place
- Save biggest bulbs for planting
